## Significant Events That Took Place in CAPERNAUM

ADEDNAL

Jesus amazes the crowds with his teaching. Mark 1:21–22 Jesus commands an evil spirit to leave a man. Mark 1:23–26 Jesus calls Peter, Andrew, James, and John to follow him. Matthew 4:18–22 Jesus calls Matthew to follow him. Matthew 9:9–13 The faith of a Roman centurion amazes Jesus. Luke 7:1–10 A woman with an issue of blood is healed. Luke 8:43–48 Jesus brings the daughter of the synagogue leader to life. Luke 8:49–56 Jesus heals a paralytic man and forgives his sins. Matthew 9:1–8 Jesus heals Peter's mother-in-law. Mark 1:29–31 Jesus gives a sermon in the synagogue on the bread of life. John 6:25–59 Jesus rebukes Capernaum for the people's unrepentant hearts. Matthew 11:20–24

### Significant Events That Took Place On or Near THE SEA OF GALILEE

CAPERNAU

Mary and Joseph settle twenty miles west of the sea. <u>Matthew 2:19–23</u> Jesus calls Peter, Andrew, James, and John to follow him. <u>Matthew 4:18–22</u> Jesus climbs a mountain near the sea and appoints the Twelve. <u>Mark 3:13–19</u> Jesus crosses the sea to deliver a demon-possessed man. <u>Mark 5:1–20</u> Jesus pays the temple tax from a fish caught in the sea. <u>Matthew 17:24–27</u> Jesus feeds 4,000 people by the shores of the sea. <u>Matthew 15:29–39</u> Jesus feeds 5,000 people by the shores of the sea. <u>Luke 9:10–17</u> Jesus falls asleep while crossing the sea and then calms a storm. <u>Mark 4:35–41</u> Jesus walks on the water of the sea in the midst of a storm. <u>Matthew 14:22–27</u> Peter walks on the water of the sea but then starts to sink. <u>Matthew 14:28–32</u> Jesus cooks breakfast for some of the disciples and restores Peter. John 21:1–25

### Significant Events That Took Place in THE TEMPLE

Jesus is presented as a child in the Temple. Luke 2:22–24 Mary and Joseph find Jesus at age twelve in the Temple. Luke 2:42–46 Satan takes Jesus to the highest point of the Temple. Matthew 4:5 Jesus cleanses the Temple the first time. John 2:13–16 Jesus teaches in the Temple at the Feast of Tabernacles. John 7:14 A woman caught in adultery is brought to Jesus at the Temple. John 8:2–6 Jesus cleanses the Temple the second time. Mark 11:15–17 Jesus teaches in the Temple as the Jewish leaders plot to kill him. Luke 19:47 Jesus heals the blind and the lame in the Temple. Matthew 21:14 People in the Temple cry out to Jesus in praise. Matthew 21:15 The veil in the Temple is torn at Jesus' death. Matthew 27:50–51

## Significant Events In and Around JESUS' TOMB

CAPERNAUM

The women arrive at the tomb find the stone rolled away. Luke 24:2–9 Mary Magdalene and the other Mary see the angel. Matthew 28:1–8 Peter and John arrive at the tomb, look in, and depart. John 20:3–10 Mary Magdalene sees two angels and then Jesus. John 20:11–18 The risen Christ sends her to inform the disciples. John 20:17–18 The women are met by the risen Christ. Matthew 28:9–10

#### Significant Events That Took Place Near CAESAREA

APERNAU

Cornelius has a vison and sends men to Joppa to find Peter. Acts 10:1–48 Paul lands in Caesarea after his second missionary journey. Acts 18:22 Paul visits Philip the Evangelist after his third missionary journey. Acts 21:8–9 Agabus prophesizes that Paul will be handed over to the Romans. Acts 21:10–11 Paul is arrested and taken to Governor Felix. Acts 23:23–24 Paul is imprisoned in Caesarea for two years. Acts 24:27 Paul appears before Governor Festus. Acts 25:6–7 Paul appears before King Agrippa and Bernice. Acts 25:23 Paul boards a ship headed for Rome. Acts 27:1–2
